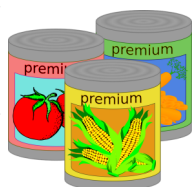
A Beetle Drive and Pancake Party will be held at Christchurch Lanner at 7pm on Saturday March 9th to celebrate the beginning of Lent.
