THE GOSPEL SET FOR SUNDAY: Matthew 9 vv9 – 13 & 18 - 26

These two passages are linked by Jesus' ministry and teaching concerning those on the edge of society. THOSE WHO WE REMEMBER THIS WEEK

MONDAY JUNE 8 Thomas Ken Bishop of Bath & Wells Non-juror 1711

Born in 1637 and ordained priest in 1662 after serving in a poor Winchester parish he moved to Winchester College. He was chaplain to Charles II and was then consecrated Bishop of Bath & Wells. After Charles II died the new king James II tried to pass laws with which Thomas and others disagreed they were all imprisoned. James fled the country and Thomas did not feel able to support a new monarch when an anointed one still lived. He was deprived of his living and spent his time writing hymns.



TUESDAY JUNE 9 Columba Abbott of Iona Missionary 597

Born in Ireland in 521 Columba founded monasteries before leaving Ireland to travel to Scotland and settled on the island of Iona. Twelve pilgrims went with him and the work grew despite being harsh and austere. He wanted to convert the heathen Scots and was successful in this.



THURSDAY JUNE 11 Barnabas Apostle

Although not listed amongst the original twelve, Barnabas features in Acts. He sold his estates and joined the Apostles. A Greek and a friend of Paul, his work involved working with converting Jews, believing that ALL are one in Christ.
