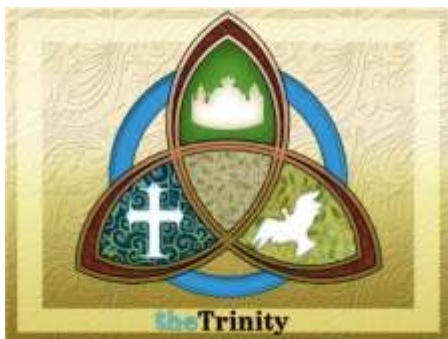

THE GOSPEL SET FOR SUNDAY: Matthew 28 vv16 - end

Known as ‘The Great Commission’ this passage, spoken by Jesus just prior to the Ascension gives the disciples a clear indication that their work is to baptise and to teach throughout the world through the power of the Holy and Undivided Trinity.

This doctrine of The Trinity emphasises the totality of God’s work in the world through Jesus: *God the creator, God the Redeemer and God the Sustainer.*

Jesus carries the name Emmanuel, which in translation means ‘God with us’. Through Jesus’ humanity we also see his divinity and thus his total involvement in our individual life and the life of the world in all of its forms.



THOSE WHO WE REMEMBER THIS WEEK

MONDAY JUNE 1 The BVM visits Elizabeth

This festival is transferred from May 31 due to the clash with Trinity Sunday. The festival first appeared in 1263 and quickly spread throughout Europe and gave an occasion for Mary's hymn of praise to be sung, 'The Magnificat'. The pregnancy of Elizabeth is the proof offered by Gabriel to Mary that she, Mary was to be the 'Theotokos' the Mother of God. It is also the first moment that John the Baptist, although unborn, recognised Jesus as the unborn Messiah.



WEDNESDAY JUNE 3 The Martyrs of Uganda 1885 – 7 / 1977

In 1886, Mwanga, the leader of Uganda had all the Christian page boys put to death when they refused his advances. A century later persecution of Christians returned and today is a day to remember them all.



THURSDAY JUNE 4 Petroc

Many Cornish churches are dedicated to Petroc which shows his importance amongst the Cornish saints. The son of a Welsh chieftan, Petroc founded a church at where is now known as Padstow. The church became a focus of monasticism, and Petroc lived there as a hermit. He is styled the 'captain of Cornish saints'.



FRIDAY JUNE 5 Boniface of Crediton Bishop Martyr 754

Boniface was born in Devon in about 675 and took that name when he entered a monastery in Exeter. Ordained at the age of 30 he became a missionary in Germany and was consecrated bishop in 722. He felled a sacred oak and as there were no consequences many were converted to Christianity. His popularity grew until he was murdered in 754, already an archbishop.



SATURDAY JUNE 6 Ini Kopuria Founder

As a local policeman, Ini Kopuria travelled all over the Solomon Islands. A vision of Jesus persuaded him to give his life to his people and the faith. He founded the Melanesian Brotherhood in 1925. Men could join for five years and many stayed longer. The Brotherhood became a powerful symbol of God's love and evangelism.
