THOSE WHO WE REMEMBER THIS WEEK

MONDAY JULY 20 Margaret of Antioch Martyr 4th century

Margaret, also known as Marina dies during the Diocletian persecutions in the fourth century. Her preaching before her martyrdom is said to have converted many.



WEDNESDAY JULY 22 Mary Magdalene

All four Gospels give Mary Magdalene a unique place among Jesus' followers and his ministry. Thought to be from Magdala by the Sea of Galilee, she was healed by Jesus and then became a follower. Among with other women, she stayed at the cross and through her witness of the resurrection and Jesus sending her to the disciples with the news, she becomes the first apostle.



THURSDAY JULY 23 Bridget of Sweden Abbess 1373

Born in Sweden in 1393, she married at 14, had eight children, and was made a widow. Early in her marriage she experienced mystical visions and founded a monastery in 1346. Her daughter became the first abbess and the order was known as Brigettine. There is a church dedicated to her on the way to St Just.

**SATURDAY JULY 25 James the Apostle 44**

James known as 'the great' and with his brother John was among the first to follow Jesus. He was among the inner group who supported Jesus in Gethsemane. James died in a time of persecution led by Herod Agrippa.
