**THE GOSPEL SET FOR SUNDAY John 20 vv1 – 18**

This well known reading which follows the resurrection concerns the meeting between Mary Magdalene and Jesus. Jesus is now in a resurrected body and Mary does not recognise him. All is confusion until Jesus says Mary’s name. Suddenly, through Jesus calling Mary’s name she recognises Jesus.

Maybe the words of Isaiah 43 flooded into Mary’s mind: “Do not be afraid, for God has redeemed you, God has called you by your name .....you are precious in God’s sight and God loves you.”

The resurrected Jesus calls us all by name. Perhaps there are times and places when we do not recognise him; until we remember he is calling us, just as we are, just who we are to respond to God’s love, made visible through the power of the cross and the resurrection.
