



#### THE BIBLE PASSAGE FOR TODAY: Luke 2 vv33 – 35

It's a strange reading for Mothering Sunday, but perhaps it reminds us of the cost of motherhood. As Mary heard Simeon's words of blessing and the strange prophecy for her son and for herself maybe she looked back to the visit from Gabriel, the arrival of the three travellers and their gifts and all the events that followed Jesus' birth and what lay before them. The mothers who have fled from Syria, Afghanistan, Ukraine and other nations holding their children must also have worried about what the future would bring.

Mary was to become a refugee mother. Herod the Great, meeting the three travellers and

learning of the Messianic prophecy and its link with Bethlehem caused him to seek a deadly solution and his response forced Mary, Joseph to take their precious child to Egypt. Did they travel like refugees today? Afraid of what might be following them, afraid of where they would sleep, live, fund their shopping etc.

Today we give thanks for all mothers, and others, who in their own way have been a mother to each one of us. For the qualities of care, understanding, courage and stability that they have given not only to their own children, but to those who rely on them day by day.

On this Mothering Sunday maybe this next prayer will reflect your thoughts on this special day:

Thank you for Mary, the mother of our Lord Jesus.
You love her and all those like her who receive your grace, obey your command, wait for your promise, and heed your Son.
May your church follow her example and walk in his true and living way. Give us, wherever we are, humility and patience as we listen to one another and reach out to our neighbours with the message and love of Christ.

#### THURSDAY MARCH 31 John Donne Priest Mystic 1631

John Donne was born in about the year 1571 and brought us a Roman Catholic, he was also the great, great nephew of Thomas More, who was executed over the matter of the 'King's divorce. John was at first sceptical about organised religion, and this continued through his education at Oxford and Cambridge until he finally discovered his faith within the Church of England. John was ordained and later became Dean of Saint Paul's Cathedral. He did much to help others discern their own vocation and to develop his own. He was loved by the people who flocked to hear his sermons.



FRIDAY APRIL 1 Frederick Denison Maurice Priest Teacher 1872

Frederick was born into a Unitarian Family (FP's father was born a Unitarian and he used to say: *One God, one devil and 20 shillings to the pound!!"*) but converted to Anglicanism and was ordained. He was a founder member of the Christian Socialist Movement and had a particular concern for the education of working class men. He wrote against the traditional concept of hell, writings which cost him his job as a Professor at Kings College. However, he was later given a similar position at Cambridge.

the United States and the European Union


to seek diligently a peaceful solution to the current tensions and beyond.
