TUESDAY JULY 22 Mary Magdalene

All four Gospels give Mary Magdalene a special place amongst Jesus' followers. Probablly from the village of Magdala on the Sea of Galilee, it is thought she was healed by Jesus before becoming a follower. She was at the cross and was the first to discover the resurrected Jesus and told by him to tell the disciples.. Hence Mary Magdalene is known as the Apostle to the Apostles.




WEDNESDAY JULY 23 Bridget of Sweden Abbess of Vadestana 1373 Born in Uppland, Sweden to a wealthy family in 1303, Bridget married at 14 and had eight children. She also had mystical experiences and when her husband died she founded an abbey for monks and nuns at Vadestana in 1346. But why, on the road to St Just is there a church dedicated to her?
