GOSPEL FOR SUNDAY: Luke 1 vv39 - 45

The angel sent Mary to Elizabeth because she was 'carrying' and was far too old. This was the proof that was offered; Elizabeth's pregnancy was miraculous, just as Mary's was. As the two woman meet Elizabeth's child turns as it hears Mary's voice. For Mary it was enough. She breaks into a song of praise, which we, thousands of years later call 'The Magnificat'.



So, what is your proof? As you approach Christmas, is it just a party, an expensive few days, a time of isolation, a time of argument, a time of celebration, a time when you know, realise or remember that you are beloved of God, and that through you Christ will once again be born into the world.



THOSE WHO WE REMEMBER DURING THE WEEK

THURSDAY DECEMBER 26 Stephen Protomartyr Deacon

In the Book of Acts, Stephen is described as one of the seven Deacons chosen to help the poor in the early church in Jerusalem. However Stephen gave a speech to the Sanhedrin which showed the history of the Jews leading to the birth of Jesus. This so enraged his audience that he was taken out and stoned. Thus he is accorded the title of: protomartyr.



FRIDAY DECEMBER 27 John Apostle Evangelist

It is not known if John the Apostle and John the Evangelist were the same person. But today we honour the one who wrote: "In the beginning was the word". John, known as the 'beloved disciple' was one of the inner circle. He was present at the Transfiguration, at the Last Supper and at the foot of the cross where Mary is given into his care. He was a witness to the resurrection and according to legend died in Ephesus.



SATURDAY DECEMBER 28 The Holy Innocents

Although Stephen is the first martyr, the Holy Innocents died before him. They died at the hand of Herod the Great who on hearing of the birth of Jesus was determined to eliminate him. This parallels with Moses who was saved when Pharoah ordered the death of Hebrew children. Moses goes on to lead God's people into the promised land. Jesus goes on to lead all people to the promised land of God's love.
