GOSPEL FOR THE FOURTH SUNDAY BEFORE LENT: Luke 2 vv33 – 35-

If you have children in your life, what do you hope for them? People usually say: "I want them to be happy". Probably we all wish that, as well as maybe hoping for grand-children, or being with our children as maybe they graduate, form a loving relationship, or get satisfaction from their professional life.

Mary would have been shocked by Simeon's prophecy concerning her son. A troublemaker, someone who would be hated, someone who would be supported by some and opposed by others.

Worse, Simeon goes on to say that the life Jesus will lead will bring his mother great pain and suffering. Mothers have the qualities of kindness, love, faithfulness and caqre. These qualities are common to all mothers whether they are birth mothers, adopting mothers, foster mothers, and of course grand-mothers. But those qualities should also apply to the church, which is why this Sunday is known as 'MOTHERING SUNDAY'. This is also why, in many settings, the token of flowers is given to ALL people regardless of gender or age. SO, to everyone: **HAPPY MOTHERING SUNDAY!!**







THOSE WHO WE REMEMBER DURING THE WEEK


MONDAY MARCH 31 John Donne Priest Poet 1631

John was born around 1571 and brought up a Roman Catholic; he was also the grandfather of Thomas More. He struggled to find the Christian faith, but when he did accepted ordination and later was appointed as Dean of St Paul's Cathedral. By now, his strong faith and sense of vocation was reflected through his sermons which people flocked to hear.



TUESDAY APRIL 1st Frederick Denison Maurice Priest Teacher 1872

Born into a Unitarian family in 1805, Frederick became an Anglican in his twenties and later ordained. He founded the Christian Socialist Movement with a particular care for the education of men. He spoke against hell which cost him his Professorship at King's College but was later offered a chair at Cambridge in 1866.
