GOSPEL FOR PENTECOST: John 14 vv9 - 17

The Gospel is perhaps about recognising Jesus in others and in actions and events that take place throughout the world. The disciples had seen the miracles and had heard the parables. Yet, they still questioned, still couldn't understand. In our turn, if we look at our life and the people we have formed relationships or friendships with, we too will have seen the proof that we need to strengthen us on our faith journey.

The great festival of Pentecost is about recognising that proof as God given, and through the life giving actions of the Holy Spirit continues to be given. The disciples began that great day as 'followers' they ended it as 'apostles' those who are being 'send out'.

Today we remember that either as a following disciple or as one who proclaims in the world, the power of the Holy Spirit surrounds you; simply turn into its light and receive God's love strength and you will achieve wonderful things in the world.



THOSE WHO WE REMEMBER DURING THE WEEK

MONDAY JUNE 9: Columba Abbot of Iona Missionary 597

Columba was born in about 521. He trained as a monk, founded monasteries and then, with 12 others went to the Island of Iona. He and others were active in mission. Iona was the starting point for Christian mission throughout Scotland.



WEDNESDAY JUNE 11: Barnabas Apostle

Although not listed amongst the first disciples, he is very active through the Book of Acts. He sold all his possessions and gave the proceeds to the Apostles common fund. He worked with Paul in Jerusalem and then, alone, was active in Antioch. He is thought to have been martyred in 61.

**SATURDAY JUNE 14: Richard Baxter Puritan Divine 1691**

Born in 1615 he served in the court of Charles I in 1633 but left, shocked by the low moral standards. Back in Shropshire he was ordained but refused to take an oath of obedience to the Episcopate in 1640. He was sent to a poor parish in the West Midlands. He opposed the Civil War and supported Charles II. Although his loyalty to the crown led to the offer of the role of Bishop of Hereford he refused and was forbidden from any further promotion. He was a great pastor and hymn writer.
