Bishop Hugh was consecrated in Lambeth Palace during COVID. Several watched that moment on television. He came to Cornwall as The suffragan Bishop of St Germans and next year will be translated to the Diocese of Worcester to be its diocesan bishop. **CONGRATULATIONS BISHOP HUGH.**

Bishop Hugh baptised a young person (at Christchurch) and confirmed members of the Pencoys Church. He has shown kindness, compassion and understanding in endless pastoral situations. He has brought energy and enthusiasm to countless liturgies in many Cornish churches. All this as well as being the Bishop to the Armed Forces.

Leave the Crypt at 7.00am


Arrive Worcester at 12.30pm

GOSPEL FOR TRINITY 19: Luke 18 vv9 – 14

This parable of 'the tithes in the temple' shows a worshipper from the church rulers looking down on, and criticising someone who he thought was 'a sinner'. The parable makes the point that 'the sinner' sought forgiveness and went home ready to begin a new life.


Perhaps we are all guilty of 'looking down' on others, of not seeking to understand a lifestyle that is different to our own. It is too easy to adopt a position where God's love for all people seems to be denied to those, who are often so in need, not only of resources and help, but also the reassurance they they are beloved of God.

The Biblical reference: Genesis 1 v27 makes it clear that God created us all in his image. Thus all are beloved of God, and all are precious in God's sight.

THOSE WHO WE REMEMBER THIS WEEK

TUESDAY OCTOBER 26 Simon & Jude Apostles

Although they are named among the apostles, little is know of Simon and Jude. Simon is often called 'The Zealot' as it is thought he belonged to a nationalistic movement. Jude it would seem is the same person as Thaddaeus. His name, so close to that of Judas meant that he was was rarely named in prayers; hence he became 'the patron saint of lost causes'.



WED. OCTOBER 29 James Hannington Bishop Martyr 1885
Born in 1847 James was ordained, served a five year curacy and then went to Uganda with the Church Missionary Society. He was consecrated Bishop and on an ill-fated tour crossed into a region ruled by King Mwanga who hated Christians. James and his companions were martyred for their faitn.



FRIDAY OCTOBER 31 Martin Luther Reformer 1548
Born in 1483 Martin Luther became a leading figure in the Protestant Reformation. He taught that humanity would be saved by faith not works. In 1517 he posted his 95 proposals / theses which were seen as a direct attack on the established church. Despite the strong opposition, the Reformation movement spread throughout Europe.


