Collect for this Sunday

God of glory, by the raising of your Son you have broken the chains of death and hell: fill your Church with faith and hope; for a new day has dawned and the way to life stands open in our Saviour Jesus Christ.

Readings for this week

Acts 10.34-43, Colossians 3.1-4, Matthew 28.1-10

Post Communion

God of Life, who for our redemption gave your only-begotten Son to the death of the cross, and by his glorious resurrection have delivered us from the power of our enemy: grant us so to die daily to sin, that we may evermore live with him in the joy of his risen life; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Gospel: Matthew 28.1-10

After the sabbath, as the first day of the week was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb. And suddenly there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord, descending from heaven, came and rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as snow. For fear of him the guards shook and became like dead men. But the angel said to the women, 'Do not be afraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples, "He has been raised from the dead, and indeed he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him." This is my message for you.' So they left the tomb quickly with fear and great joy, and ran to tell his disciples. Suddenly Jesus met them and said, 'Greetings!' And they came to him, took hold of his feet, and worshipped him. Then Jesus said to them, 'Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me.'

WE ARE AN EASTER PEOPLE AND "ALLELUIA" IS OUR SONG (Alleluia, comes from a Hebrew word meaning: "Praise the Lord".)

Despite the virus crisis, Easter has not been cancelled. You may have seen a service on ZOOM or followed prayers and readings through the many resources that are now on the Internet. But Easter 2020 could be best known for all the people who pushed back the darkness and brought light into lives that were struggling. This mirrors the story of the first Easter, where Jesus pushed back the darkness of the cross and brought the light of hope and love into the world through the miracle of the resurrection.

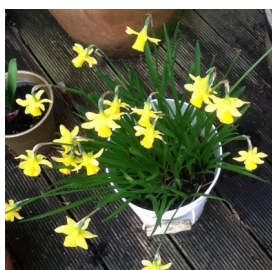
