

INSTALLATION OF REV'D CHRIS

Rev'd Chris will be installed as Vicar with oversight of the Benefice of Towan Blystra and Rector of the Benefice of St Wenn and Withiel at St Michael's Church, Newquay, on Monday March 30th at 7pm, if you'd like to attend and support Chris and the family.

NEW BISHOP OF ST GERMAN'S

The next Bishop of St Germans is to be the Rev'd James Treasure.

James was ordained priest in 2017 and from 2018 he served as Vicar and Resource Church Leader at St Thomas and St Luke's (locally known as "Top Church") in Dudley.

In 2023, James was also appointed Team Rector for the wider Dudley parish. In this role, he maintained responsibility for four additional churches while continuing his leadership at St Thomas and St Luke's.

He will be consecrated as a Bishop on May 1st in St Paul's Cathedral, London, after which he will formally be welcomed to the diocese and will take up his seat in Truro Cathedral in a service on May 10th at 4.30pm. All welcome. Further details are available on the Truro Diocese website.

NEW ARCHDEACON DESIGNATE OF BODMIN

The Rev'd Dr Helen Williams has been named as the new Archdeacon Designate of Bodmin. Helen is currently Team Vicar in Shaftesbury Benefice in the Diocese of Salisbury.

Helen's background is in astrophysics, and after having children, she was licensed as a Reader in Winchester Diocese and also trained as a science teacher. After moving to Dorset, she became a Licensed Lay Minister in Salisbury Diocese. She served her curacy in the parish of Wareham in Dorset, before moving to her present post.

While Helen's start date has yet to be confirmed, it is expected that she will be in post in the summer. Further details are available on the Truro Diocese website.
