**Gospel**

'Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air; they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? And can any of you by worrying add a single hour to your span of life? And why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not clothed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you—you of little faith? Therefore do not worry, saying, "What will we eat?" or "What will we

drink?" or "What will we wear?" For it is the Gentiles who strive for all these things; and indeed your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

'So do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring worries of its own. Today's trouble is enough for today.

**Intincting / dipping communion wafers.** Quite a number of people choose to dip / intinct their communion wafer in the communion wine, but the Coronavirus issue has caused the clergy and reader team to review this practice. At the moment we have no directive from the Diocese, but our own review has highlighted that after having shaken hands with numerous people at the Peace, when the wafer is placed on our hands, and then we pick it up and dip it in the wine (sometimes a finger can touch the wine too) we have an issue.

The teaching of the Church is that it is as efficacious to receive in one kind (just bread OR wine) as in two kinds. So if for any reason you do not want to drink direct from the chalice, please receive in one kind only.

**Funeral of Christina Chesterfield.** Sadly Christina Chesterfield, of Treleigh Church and previously St Andrew's, has died - her funeral is at St Paul's Church, Chacewater on Monday 17th February at 2pm. Christina's family would love her friends from both churches to be present if at all possible.
