Bishop Hugh baptised a young person (at Christchurch) and confirmed members of the Pencoys Church. He has shown kindness, compassion and understanding in endless pastoral situations and has brought energy and enthusiasm to countless liturgies in many Cornish churches. All this as well as being the Bishop to the Armed Forces.

GOSPEL FOR TRINITY 8: Luke 12 vv32 – 40

Last Sunday when the Anglicans and Methodists came together in Lanner for a combined Eucharist, the Methodist minister, MO spoke about the need to be ready. That is exactly what today's Gospel is saying.

It is no good waiting for a dramatic event to realise that God is with you, God is already there. God is in the shelter for homeless people, God is in the intensive care unit in Treliske, God is beside you as you read this short passage.

We are called to recognise God in our everyday lives, because, if we wait for the dramatic event, it may not happen. God is with you in bthe darkness as well as in the light, in bthe vrough as well as the smooth, in the laughter as well as in the tears. God has been with us all along, we just have to recognise him and realise God is with us. Just as the angel said to Mary: "You shall call his name Emmanuel, which means, God with us"



THOSE WHO WE REMEMBER THIS WEEK

MONDAY AUGUST 11: Clare of Assisi Founder 1253

Born in 1193 to a wealthy family, Clare was influenced by Francis of Assisi. She founded her own contemplative order and was the first person to write a monastic rule for women. Some of her last words were:

"Blessed be God for having created me"



WEDNESDAY AUGUST 13: Jeremy Taylor Bishop of Down & Connor 1667 Born in Cambridge in 1613 and educated in the city, Jeremy was ordained in 1633. He was a chaplain to the royalist forces in the civil war, captured and went to Wales on release. Through his writings, Jeremy went to Ireland in 1658, where he was made bishop. He was caught up in disputes between religious groups and died of ill health as a resukt of the conflicts.



THURSDAY AUGUST 14: Maximillian Kolbe Friar Martyr 1941
Born in Poland in 1894 he trained for ordination and through ill health produced a magazine for Christians which had a wide circulation. In May 1941 he was arrested as an intellectual and sent to Auschwitz. Here he gave up his life so that another might live.
